

Rig Equipment Recertification Services

Provides drilling contractors OEM certification with minimal OEM involvement

Applications

- The program is applicable to Cameron and other OEM land and offshore rig equipment, including top drives, drawworks, mud pumps, and rotary tables.
- This program excludes pressure control equipment.

How it works

Rig equipment recertification

- Provides customers with technical support during overhaul and Category IV maintenance activities
- Enables the customer to perform the work internally with minimal oversight and guidance from Cameron
- Determines level of Cameron involvement and presence on location during the overhaul process according to the agreed-upon maintenance procedure
- Issues a certificate of conformance (COC) at the end of the process

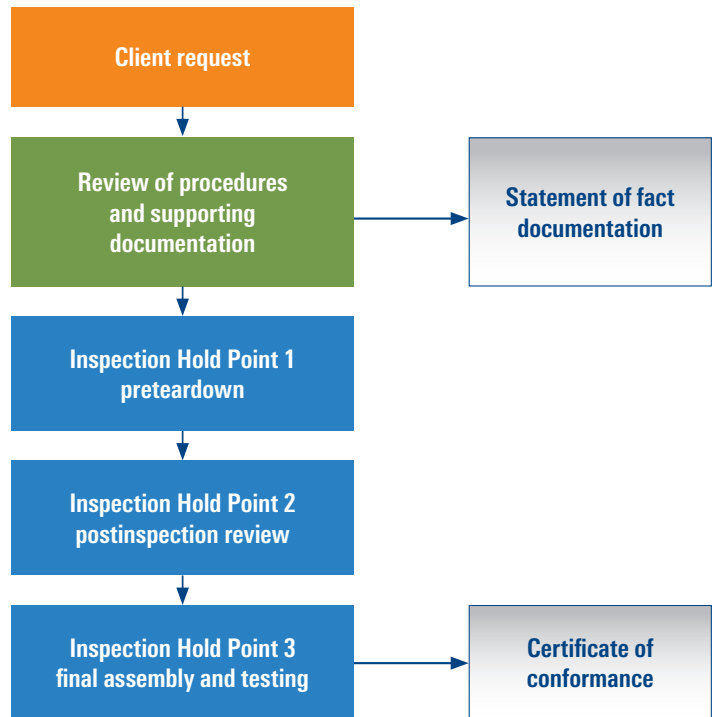
The process

- Procedure review
Conduct documentation review on customer’s internal maintenance procedures based on OEM and API recommendations.
- Inspection services
Monitor customer’s maintenance activities at set intervals to validate condition of equipment.
- Quality records review
Verify inspection and traceability records support the equipment evaluation, overhaul plan, and dispositions of repairs.
- Issue COC
Validate the equipment has been maintained, repaired, and tested as per procedures and meets API guidelines.

Target customers

- requiring an OEM-issued COC for major overhaul or recertification of rig equipment
- experiencing reliability or service quality issues with equipment
